

What is available for my class at Elstree and Borehamwood Museum?

Object handling sessions: our resource boxes can support work across the curriculum including Local History, Geography, Literacy and Social Skills.

The loan boxes currently available are:

- The Home Front 1939-1945
- Change: Now and Then
- The First World War 1914-1918

The contents of the boxes may vary, but all boxes will contain some of the following:

- Original or replica artefacts
- Posters
- Photographs

£50 all day.
